Questions and Answers from Webinar Presentations

Q: Any design that helps the community cross the corridors? Since street crossing is crucial for the road safety.

A: Great question! Yes, we are adding protected right turns for bikes at intersections.

Q: Does the screen also provide sound buffer?

A: Yes, it's a 2-inch concrete screen, although it's not a sound wall, it will mitigate soe sound.

Q: How does summer heat impact the constructions season in Oddie Wells project (if it does impact it)?

A: The team has been coordinating with the cities since the inception of this project. The cities are responsible for the maintenance. We have also committed to maintain the landscape for 1 year after construction to make sure trees thrive prior the cities take over.

Q: Why the team decided to use fence instead of vegetation as noise barrier?

A: Maintenance, and it is not a noise barrier. It's a privacy screen to cover or replace the existing wooden back fences that face Oddie.

Q: How has the project planned for tree maintenance to ensure the trees can have maximal chances of reaching maturity, maximal carbon sequestration, etc?
