### Questions and Answers from Webinar Presentations

*Q: For Camila - Who is around the table during the prioritization stages? Can you share how Spin structures and manages this?*

A: We and our partners meet with the initial contact, who then brings in SMEs as necessary for future collaboration. This includes a PM, Data Expert, and Tech Translator. We coordinate meetings and different touching points with the jurisdictions/organizations to ensure we have as much data and knowledge as possible to develop the pilot.

*Q: What are the factors/data points that get input into the decision tool to ensure more equitable decisions and outcomes?*

A: It's a combination of open source data and data provided by the jurisdiction/organization.

*Q: Camila - can you also speak to the lunch and learn series. Who participates? how do you connect with those people?*

A: Of course! Anybody interested in contributing to our model/framework development can join. As I mention, we want to reduce as many blind spots as possible and want leaders from different backgrounds/expertise.
