Brittany is currently an Advisor to the NOAA Chief Scientist and also serves as a U.S. negotiator for science-related items under the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) and the Global Stocktake. Throughout her career, she has worked on a wide range of environmental policy issues including the *Deepwater Horizon* oil spill, addressing coastal wetland loss, capacity building, and increasing engagement with new partners including the private sector. Brittany has served on multiple U.S. delegations for the UNFCCC, Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, and World Meteorological Organization. She has a Bachelor's degree in Environmental Studies from Franklin and Marshall College, a Master's degree in Global Environmental Policy from American University, and a Master's degree from Johns Hopkins University in Energy Policy and Climate and National Security Studies.

Timo is a researcher and policy advisor on climate change adaptation and a PhD candidate at the Grantham Research Institute on Climate Change and the Environment at the London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE). He is a renowned expert on monitoring and evaluation of climate adaptation on which he has authored numerous journal articles, guidebooks and training materials. Timo is a contributing author of the IPCC Sixth Assessment Report, Working Group II on Impacts, Adaptation and Vulnerability, and a lead author of UNEP's annual Adaptation Gap Report. Prior to joining LSE, Timo worked at Germany's international development agency (GIZ) including as head of support for adaptation to the Tanzanian government. Timo has been advising several government ministries on adaptation to climate change and has been observing the UN climate change negotiations since 2015.
